This is a selection phase to send top twelve paintings at the Asia Pacific Children's Painting Contest on Quality.

1. **Theme:** "I love the wonderful life"
2. **Date:** 30th July 2016 (15 Shrawan 2073), Saturday
Time: 11:00 am to 3:00 pm
3. **Venue:** Nepal Art Council, Babar Mahal,, Kathmandu
4. **Eligible participants:** Below 15 years
(Participating students should not cross 15 years of age on 10th September 2016 or should have born on/after September 09, 2001)
5. **No. of participants from School:** 3 students per school
6. **Subjects for painting::**
 - Good Quality in our life or study
 - Green development for colorful life
 - The harmonious development of human, environment and animals that we aspire
 - Saving resources, protecting the environment, caring for nature
 - Let's create and enjoy high quality together
 - Adhere to the quality and integrity, against counterfeit and shoddy products
6. **Painting Paper:** Nepali Lokta paper, Size: 4 K (42 cm x 59.4 cm) (**Paper will be provided by the organizer**)
7. **Painting Media:** Water color (**Painting color will be provided by the organizer**)
8. **Painting materials:** Pencil, brush and other painting materials should be brought by the participating students themselves
9. **Awards:** The 12 best winners will each be awarded Rs. 3,000 cash prize, a special souvenir and a certificate of merit. **The top twelve paintings will be sent to compete at the 2nd Asia Pacific Children's Painting Contest on Quality in China.**
10. **Registration:** All students participating in the contest must register their names in the prescribed registration form. Last day of registration is **25th July 2016**
11. **Registration fee: Rs. 300 (Rs. Three hundred only) per participant**
12. **Copyright of paintings:** The copyright of awarded printings will belong to the organizer, NQPCN. The 12 best paintings selected for awards will be compiled and printed in the form of Calendar 2017 and distributed as souvenir to related organizations and individuals nationally and internationally through its network
